



Spring 2022 Scholarship Guidelines and Instructions

- * Available to students that are currently enrolled in college and whose family is involved with the horse racing community.
- * Scholarships applicants must have a GPA greater than 2.5; and be enrolled in a community college, university, technical, vocational or trade school.
- * Applicants must provide a short essay stating why they should receive a scholarship from the Foundation.
- * Applicants must provide 2 references the Foundation can contact.
- * Applicants must provide current itemized statement from the University and a current transcript (high school or college) must also be sent with the application
- * Please provide a thank you note to donors and sponsors of the foundation.

Scholarship funds will be paid **January 2022 for the Spring 2022 semester and will be paid directly to the school and not to the student.** All items required must be submitted before the check will be mailed. Failure to complete any of these items will result in a forfeiture of the scholarship.
